On November 13, 2020 Sage School will be hosting our 8th Annual Clay Shoot at the beautiful Burge Plantation in Mansfield, GA. Sage is a non-profit Christian school located in Suwanee, GA that educates students with dyslexia to exit into traditional schools and be successful. We have our students for a short time, typically 2-4 years. In those critical years we give our students the tools necessary to become literate, to become confident, to become successful.

Funds raised from the annual Clay Shoot help:

- Saving lives of students who struggle...
 - It is estimated that up to 15% (close to one in seven) of the population has dyslexia – a language-based learning disability. (National Institute of Health)
 - o 44% of females and 57% of males with learning disabilities drop out of high school. (National Adult Literacy Survey)
 - Only 13% of students with learning disabilities attend any post-secondary school program. (National Longitudinal Transition Study)
 - o 50% of juvenile delinquents tested were found to have undetected learning disabilities. (National Center for State Courts and the Educational Testing Service)
 - o 60% of adolescents in treatment for substance abuse have learning disabilities. (Hazelden Foundation)
 - o 31% of adolescents with learning disabilities will be arrested 3-5 years out of high school. (National Longitudinal Transition Study)
 - o Up to 40 percent of all adults on welfare have learning disabilities. (Learning Disability Institute).

- o The leading variable accounting for suicides among youths under the age of 14 is learning disabilities. (Director of the Los Angeles Suicide Prevention Center)

- Deliver teacher training and continuing education
- Provide the greater Gwinnett and Athens communities with dyslexia information, tutoring and referral services
